IT Transition on Schedule

ACS Training Begins

As required by the Transfer Agreement, a new IT system will be activated at MGH upon the transfer. MHD has been working with ACS to assure that the IT transition will go smoothly and without interruption to MGH's operations. ACS has begun training staff to manage MGH's new IT system.

As an added layer of security, MHD, ACS and Sutter have coordinated a contingency plan that will ensure IT continuity should unanticipated issues arise during the transfer.

Amending the Hospital Lease

Lease will be Updated to Reflect Modern Operations

During the last Regular Board meeting, MHD reviewed a summary of proposed amendments to the 1985 Hospital Lease. The revisions to the lease will reflect modern operations, remove obsolete provisions, add provisions necessary to address the transfer and accommodate the seismic compliance needs.

The proposed amendments include the following provisions:

- obligating MGH Corp. to cooperate to plan/develop/fund and construct the planned seismic retrofit/new construction.
- an express non-competition prohibition for MGH Corp. This provision was ambiguous in the original lease.
- strengthening MGH Corp.'s obligations related to use for
