

Marin County: Daily COVID-19 Cases


Case Legend:

■ Daily New Confirmed Cases




How many Marin residents have been vaccinated?




Marin County Residents: Daily Doses


What Groups are Being Vaccinated in Marin?

- Healthcare workers
- Persons age 75 or older
- Age 65 plus starting next week



Marin County: COVID-19 Mortality and Age

COVID-19 Mortality Rate



A vaccine given to someone age 75 and older is:

- **332 times** more likely to prevent a death than a vaccine given to someone age 0-49
- **34 times** more likely to prevent a death than a vaccine given to someone age 50-64
- **4 times** more likely to prevent death than a vaccine given to someone age 65-74

COVID-19 Vaccine

The health and safety of Marin County residents is our top priority. A COVID-19 vaccine is one of the most important tools to end the COVID-19 pandemic. A safe, effective, no-cost COVID-19 vaccine will be available to everyone in Marin County. Getting vaccinated can prevent you from getting the virus. It can also protect those around you from getting infected. The vaccine paired with other daily health habits, such as social distancing, wearing masks, and washing hands, will help us end the COVID-19 pandemic so businesses and schools can fully reopen and we can return to a more normal way of life.

Supply is still slow to arrive in Marin, but we anticipate bringing more partners and vaccination locations online very soon.

- 1/23/21: We have updated this page to include new features. Please review our "quick links" section below to access our vaccine dashboard, participate in a perceptions survey, sign-up to be notified when you're eligible to receive the vaccine, and more.
- 1/21/21: Marin Public Health and local health care partners are prioritizing people age 75 & older as the next group for vaccination as part of Phase 1B. There is a growing list of vaccine providers in Marin County and as supply allows, those providers will begin offering vaccines to Marin County residents age 75 & older (in addition to vaccinating remaining Phase 1A-eligible health care workers and residents of long-term care facilities).

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
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
